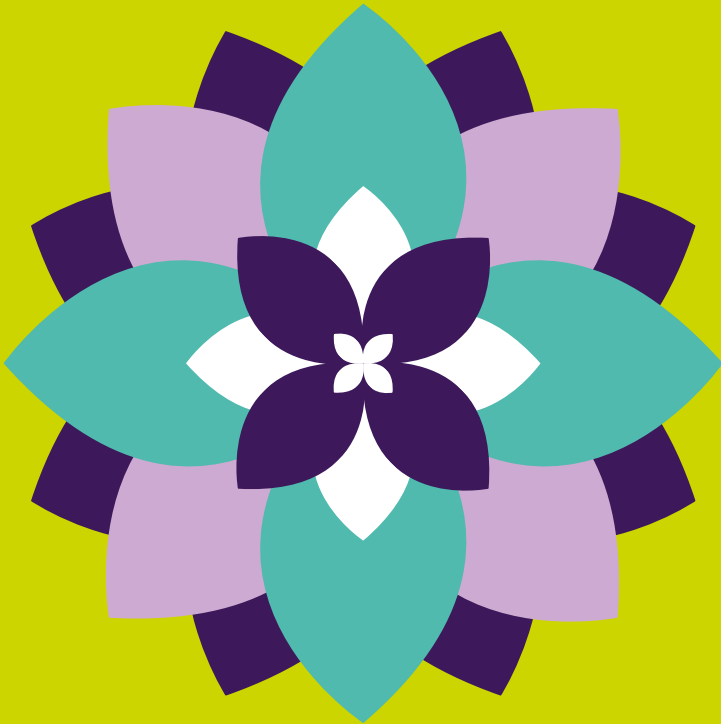

In memory giving

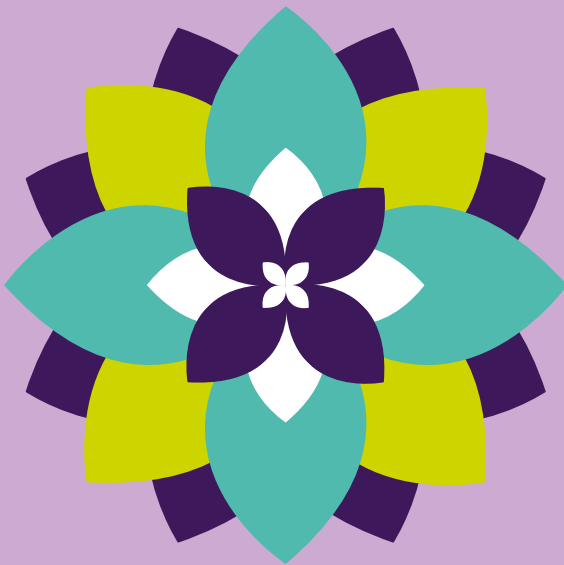
